Description

Flower arranging basket made of bamboo (madake). The basket starts with a square, flat base and gradually

softens its shape to become more spherical. At the same time, the plait changes to groups of 1/4-inch split bamboo strips. This "bunching" action separates the rim into two congregations of looped sections. The handle rises from this. Handle: A group of layered strips of 1/4-inch bamboo attach at the rim area; they then twist over the basket in a shallow arc.
